Prince Dr. Emmanuel Anyangwe Ngassa was born on 8th May 1966 in Victoria (Limbe) in Cameroon. His father was Fon Adii L. Anyangwe the 3rd, the Fon of Oshie, a Fondom in the North West Region of Cameroon. He was brought up in Ghana Street in Bamenda under the loving care of his grandmother, Ma' Mary. He attended primary school from 1971 to 1978 at Roman Catholic School Bayelle. He later attended secondary school from 1978 to 1983 and high school from 1983 to 1985 at the Catholic all boys' boarding school Sacred Heart College Mankon still in Bamenda, graduating with the Cameroon General Certificate of Education Ordinary (1983) and Advanced (1985) Levels. After a one year intermezzo at the state university of Yaounde (1985/1986) he moved to Europe on 25th July 1986 first to Italy, where he perfected his knowledge of Italian, before finally moving on to Germany as a scholarship student of the Republic of Cameroon in 1987 where he subsequently read medicine at the Georg-August-University Göttingen from 1988 to 1995 when he qualified as a medical doctor on 13.12.1995. His career as a medical doctor has seen him gather experiences in many different departments including internal medicine, anesthesia, cardiac, thoracic, vascular, accident, visceral and neurosurgery. He qualified as a General Surgeon on 09.09.2009. From 20th September to 20th December 2013 he worked as Medical Advisor on the cruise ship AIDA*diva*. He works now as a surgeon in Germany.

He is very sociable and a very good entertainer too. People like his company very. He is a very strong advocate of justice. He is very active in many social groups. Part of his free time is spent as an active member of the local voluntary fire brigade. He is a member of a sports club, ATGV Witzenhausen-Kleinalmerode, where he once was an active football player. His hobbies include filming and documentation. Some of his video productions can be watched on YouTube on his channel Manunga Studio. He is a strong defender of the rights for minorities. He got his PhD in Medicine on 30.10.2000 after successfully defending his doctoral dissertation about traditional medicine in Cameroon which he deliberately tackled in order to promote that aspect of inherited knowledge from his beloved Cameroon. He speaks 7 languages of which 4 are European (English, French, German & Italian), and 3 from Cameroon (Pidgin English, Bamena & Lamnso). Early in 2013 Prince Dr. Anyangwe Ngassa unsuccessfully tried to find a publisher for his autobiography. Instead he was confronted with a general atmosphere of disinterest on the part of German publishers. The few that showed some interest turned out to be more interested in making money asking for horrendous sums to be paid by the author into their coffers. With no alternative left he decided to tackle the bull by the horn and promptly founded his own publishing house on 17th June 2013, Manunga Publishing. Since then he has been quickly establishing himself as a very reliable and able alternative publisher for disadvantaged authors especially those hailing from Africa. In August 2013 he published his own very first book, Manungas Lehrbuch Pidgin Englisch/Deutsch (ISBN: 978-3-944785-004), the first book of its kind at all. With the publishing of his first animal tale, he has taken his publications one step further to meet the high demand for African tales, told and written by Africans themselves.
